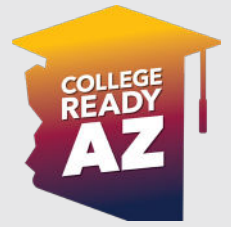


Cuenta Studentaid.gov (FSA ID) Guía paso a paso para crearla



¿Qué es una cuenta de Studentaid.gov?

La cuenta de Studentaid.gov, también conocida como identificación de ayuda federal para estudiantes (FSA), es un nombre de usuario y una contraseña que se requieren para iniciar sesión y acceder a todos los sitios web de ayuda federal para estudiantes, incluyendo la FAFSA. La identificación FSA también sirve como firma legal cuando envías tu FAFSA.

Visita la página studentaid.gov y haz clic en «crear cuenta» en la esquina superior derecha. La solicitud está disponible en inglés y español.

Selecciona Español en la esquina superior derecha para crear una cuenta en español.

¿Quién debe crear una cuenta en Studentaid.gov?

Debes crear una cuenta en Studentaid.gov para poder comenzar a llenar la FAFSA. Uno o ambos de tus papás también deberán crear una cuenta en Studentaid.gov en caso de que su información sea necesaria para completar el formulario de la FAFSA. Si eres un estudiante independiente, no será necesario que tus padres o tutores legales creen una cuenta en Studentaid.gov. Si tienes un hermano que asistió a la universidad antes que tú, es posible que tus papás ya tengan una cuenta en Studentaid.gov.

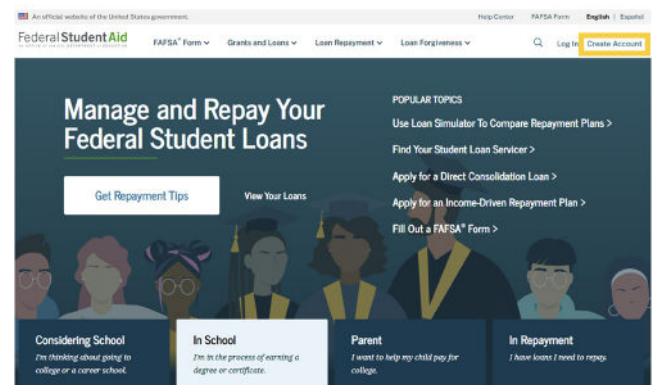

What's Next?

Before we can grant full account access, we must confirm that your name, Social Security number, and date of birth all match what is on record with the Social Security Administration (SSA). This process takes one to three days. If you verified your email address, you'll receive an email once your information is matched with the SSA.

You can still use your account while your information is being verified with the SSA.
